SIGHTSEEING DAY 1: CHANDIGARH / DELHI TO SHIMLA

Arrive at Chandigarh railway station/airport and transfer to **Shimla** Known as the Summer Capital of The Britishers, and currently the capital of Himachal Pradesh, Shimla is one of India's most popular hill resorts, buzzing with a happy flow of heat-escaping Indian vacationers. Situated at a height of 2200m, Shimla still retains its old-world charm with beautiful colonial architecture, pedestrian-friendly Mall Road, and the ridge lined up with multiple shops, cafes, and restaurants. Overnight at the Hotel.



DAY 2: SHIMLA

After Breakfast Excursion to Kufri. Kufri is famous for its Himalayan National Park, Pony and Yak Ride and One can see the endless Himalayan Panorama from Kufri, after lunch sight-seeing of various places in and around. **Jakhoo Temple, Vice regal Lodge** built-in (1885), **Botanical Garden, Christ Church** built in (1844), **The Gaiety Theatre**- the first beauty contest of world was supposed to start (1887), **The Ridge**: The Ridge is an indispensable part of Shimla. Apart from being the cultural center, it houses the city's lifeline -the water reservoir with the capacity of storing 1000000 gallons of water. These water tanks placed under the Ridge supply water to the entire town. The **Scandal Point** and the famous **Shopping Plaza** of the North Mall. O/N Hotel **Kali Bari Temple**. A wooden image of goddess Kali, to whom this temple is dedicated, is worshipped here. Just walking distance from The Main Mall Road visit this temple for a dose of spirituality and religion. **Town Hall** This architectural marvel, which dates back to the colonial period; adds to the beauty of the surrounding architectural remains of the pre-independence era and is a must-visit place for all admirers of skill and structural design. Overnight at the Hotel.



DAY 3: SHIMLA TO MANALI

After breakfast check out from the hotel a distance of 265 km 8 hrs. on the way visit Sunder Nagar, Pandoh Dam, Hanogi Mata Temple, Kullu Valley Also known as the Queen of Hill stations and a mecca for adventure sports enthusiasts, overnight at the Hotel



DAY 4: MANALI

After breakfast sightseeing in places in and around Manali, Like **Hadimba temple**- Also known by the name **Dhungri Temple**, as the name suggests, the temple is dedicated to **Hidimba Devi**, wife of Bheema. **Manu temple**, **Vashisht Bath**, (trek/**Walk to Jogini Fall** optional), Van Vihar, and evening shopping at the local market. Overnight at the Hotel.



DAY 5: MANALI

After breakfast excursion to Solang Valley Located at about 8400 feet above sea level, Solang Nala is a short drive away from Manali. Overnight at the Hotel, At the top of the pass the air seems to glitter against the snow as you look down over herringboned ridges into the Lahaul valley. Evening at Leisure. O/N Hotel


DAY 6: MANALI TO DHARAMSHALA

After breakfast Check out and proceed to Dharamshala A distance of 260 kilometers on the way stopping at The **Baijnath temple** located in the hilly state of Himachal Pradesh holds high religious importance amongst followers of Hinduism. It is a highly popular temple as it houses one of the 12 holy jyotirlingas of Lord Shiva in the country and devotees from across the country throng the temple to offer prayers to the Lord known for its Shiva Temple and further at **Palampur** is a beautiful hill station located in Kangra Valley about 35 km from Dharamshala. It gets its its name from pulum meaning 'abundant water'. Unsurprisingly, the region has innumerable streams and brooks and the water bodies are a huge boon for the **tea plantations** For Tea Garden Overnight at the hotel.



DAY 7: DHARAMSHALA TO DALHOUSIE

After Breakfast drive from Dharamshala towards Dalhousie after doing the local sightseeing of Places which includes, **St. John in the Wilderness Church**: St. John in the Wilderness, located near Dharamshala and on the way to Mcleod Ganj, this neo-gothic church was built in dedication to John the Baptist. **Dalai lama Temple**: Dalai Lama Temple is just a walking distance away from Mcleod Ganj bus stand, the Dalai Lama Temple is situated at the main temple road. Right next to the temple is the residence of the holy Dalai Lama. Dalai lama Temple offers spiritual teachings of Buddhism. Bhagsunath Temple: Surrounded by lovely pools and lush greenery, the **Bhagsunag Temple** is one of the oldest ancient temples located about 3 kilometers from Mcleodganj. Also popularly known as Bhagsunath Temple His Holiness Dalai lama's residence at Mc Leodgunj, War Memorial, Bhagsunath Temple, and **Dal Lake** Located at the height of 1,775 meters above the sea level near the village of Tota Rani at Mcleodgunj, the Dal Lake is a small yet picturesque lake. The lake is surrounded by rugged mountains and towering deodar trees. Set amidst lush deodar forests, this peaceful edifice is known for its Belgian stained-glass windows. Overnight at hotel



DAY 8: DALHOUSIE

After breakfast local sightseeing at **Dalhousie**, a popular hill station in Himachal Pradesh is situated at a height of 1,970 meters above sea level, famous for its meadows, dense jungles, and waterfalls and Excursion to **Panchpula** is a popular picnic spot located at a distance of 3.5 km from Gandhi Chowk in Dalhousie, surrounded by a cover of green pine and deodar trees. It is best known for Saptdhara Waterfall **Khajjiar**, 26 km from Dalhousie also known as the 'mini-Switzerland of India', Khajjiar is a small town located around 26 km from Dalhousie, known for its picture-perfect grassy meadows. There is a small lake in the middle of the meadows. There are plenty of day activities you can enjoy at your own cost like paragliding, zorbing, and horse-riding at Khajjiar to make your day pleasant. **St Patrick's** Church is one of the oldest churches in Dalhousie. Located near, Dalhousie Cantonment just 2 km away from the main bus stand. The dome-shaped shrine attracts not just devotees but also many history buffs and architecture lovers and is known to have been established by a group of the British army. Overnight at the hotel.



Day 9: Dalhousie to Chandigarh/Delhi

Check out from the hotel and transfer to Chandigarh a drive of around 6 hours and drop at railway station/airport.




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
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
